After smoke damage, it is natural to want to start cleaning. Timely action can be a great help, but incorrect or delayed action can jeopardize or seriously impede satisfactory restoration.

Removal of severe odors from fire & smoke damage requires a variety of professional products, systems & specialty equipment.

Air Scrubbers

In any situation where there is fire damage, smoke and odor particles continue to be airborne many days after the fire has stopped. Air scrubbers use High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filtration to remove these particles from the air, clearing the air for safe breathing.

Thermal Fogging

This process neutralizes odor, using a strong deodorizer that penetrates everywhere the smoke traveled and will require the removal of pets, plants, and human occupants for a short period of time. This process is done on-site.

Ozone

Ozone is an oxidizing agent produced by an ozone generator. This is a powerful deodorizer and is harmful to pets, plants, and humans and therefore must be performed at our facility.

*Most importantly, **DO NOT TOUCH ANYTHING!** The oils on your hands will set soot stains into the things that you touch and make it difficult or impossible to remove.*
